Module 1

KAO provides a module for intensive songwriting/rehearsing/performing.

JAO/Gradia provides a rehearsing/performance module for developing skills for specific areas within so called world music.

Rijn Ijssell provides a module in specified areas of music business (creating a concept, branding, promotion etc)

Every partner specifies their needs and what they can offer.
